## **DIRECTIVES FOR AEROLOGICAL SOUNDING EQUIPMENT**

### **PART 02      Equipment Maintenance Notes**

Maintenance notes establish daily procedures for maintenance and logistics activities of electronics technicians and augment technical information in equipment manuals. They assist technicians in following the correct procedures in maintaining electronic systems. Maintenance notes provide information not generally found in other sources and are basically the means by which technicians are kept informed of changes related to specific equipment and systems. They are issued only by the WSH Maintenance Branch, the sole authority for establishing maintenance policy, and are distributed to all electronics technicians and on a selective basis to other organizational units requiring the information.

Revisions to existing material are made to enhance maintenance effectiveness and to update obsolete technical information. Maintenance notes are developed from numerous sources of input throughout the organization and constitute an important supplement to other technical documents.

Maintenance notes are indexed for ease of reference and are consecutively numbered by date of issue. The Electronics Systems Analyst shall periodically check that each electronics technician has all current notes available. Missing material should be requested from the National Logistics Supply Center (NLSC).
